Title: Santa Maria Flood Zone Increased Appropriation for Capital Projects.

Budget Action: Increase Appropriations of \$175,000 in the Public Works Department Santa Maria Flood Zone 3 Fund for Capital Assets-Construction in Progress funded by the release of Restricted Fund Balance.

Justification: This Budget Revision releases \$175,000 in Restricted Fund Balance in the Santa Maria Flood Zone and increases Fixed Asset Line Item Account 8700 Construction in Progress for two capital improvement projects. The first project, SM8313 -- Unit II Channel Improvements, is intended to improve the conveyance capacity of the Unit II Channel. Currently there is a constriction in the channel of both narrowed width and inefficient horizontal alignment. The alignment is being smoothed out and the width is being increased, both resulting in increased conveyance capacity. In order to convey these increased flows through the Santa Maria River Levee, through which the Unit II Channel exits as it daylights into the river, project SM8205 -- West Green Canyon is intended to increase the capacity of flow through the culvert. This project will provide two additional 72-inch diameter culverts to supplement the existing box culvert. These projects as described above increase conveyance and flood protection to the area.

Title: CSD - Parks - Windamajig Restoration Project

Budget Action: Increase appropriations of \$10,000 in Community Services Department, Parks Division, General Fund for Services and Supplies funded by a donation from the Bermant Foundation (\$6,000) and a release of Restricted Fund Balance (\$4,000).

Justification: The Windamajig at Goleta Beach is one of several kinetic art installations created by the famous sculptor George Rhoads. The sculpture includes wheel-like assemblies that rotate in opposite directions and is powered by the wind. The Windamajig was installed in 1992 and has not gone through any major renovations. Due to its location, the marine environment and nature of the rotating components, a major renovation is warranted at this time. The renovation will be funded by the Bermant Foundation and the Arts Commission.

Title: Access Vehicle Fund reserves for replacement vehicle purchases

Budget Action: Increase appropriations of \$1,967,566 in the General Services Vehicle Operations & Maintenance Fund for Capital Assets funded by the release of Retained Earnings.

Justification: This budget revision establishes funding for unanticipated requests for replacements from several departments including: Fire (\$736k), Sheriff (\$332k), Agricultural Commissioner (\$166k), Parks (\$106k), Probation (\$103k), and various other departments (\$525k). These requests meet approved criteria for replacement of vehicles. The source of these funds for the replacements is the Vehicle Operations reserves which have been collected on a monthly basis from our customers for the purpose of replacing the vehicles as they age. The total amount of this budget revision is \$1,967,566.

Title: CSD - Parks Capital Project - AB Beach Boardwalk

- Budget Action: Increase appropriations of \$220,000 in Community Services Department, Parks Division, Capital Projects Fund for Capital Assets Construction in Progress funded by unanticipated revenue from Developer Mitigation Fees and Quimby Fees.
- Justification: Arroyo Burro Beach Park is a popular County beach in Santa Barbara that is frequented by over 700,000 visitors on an annual basis. Aside from being a frequently used beach (and dog beach), the beach park has a popular restaurant on site as well as a watershed resource center. A 6,750 sf. decomposed granite (dirt) pathway along the estuary currently exists at the park, and is the main path of travel from the easterly section of the parking lot and bus stop. The proposed project would install an eco-friendly, well-lit boardwalk in place of the existing decomposed granite pathway and provide a well improved walking path for visitors. The project costs would cover the design, tree & habitat protection plan, construction and management. Sources of funding are Fund 1405 Developer Mitigation Fees South Coast West (\$102,000) and Fund 1400 Quimby Fees South Coast West (\$118,000). Unencumbered fund balances for Fund 1400 and Fund 1405 are approximately \$118K and \$558K, respectively.
