RESOLUTION FOR COMMENDATION FOR DAVID CHEN AND CORINA TREVINO EMPLOYEES OF THE MONTH, MARCH 2014

WHEREAS, the Santa Barbara County District Attorney Truancy Program team of David Chen, Deputy District Attorney, and Corina Trevino, Legal Office Professional, are the March 2014 Employees of the Month; and

WHEREAS, David Chen and Corina Trevino are recognized for their outstanding performance and dedication in serving the children, parents, and schools in Santa Barbara County through their continuing and untiring efforts to keep kids in school and provide necessary support, counseling, and intervention to children and families at risk to crime and crime-victimization in our communities, including performing approximately 7,000 successful interventions and requiring only 3 prosecutions; and,

WHEREAS, David Chen and Corina Trevino are outstanding role models to all members of our community as their individual efforts make a lifelong difference to the children, families and schools they assist in our county; and,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors recognizes David Chen and Corina Trevino as the March 2014 County of Santa Barbara Employees of the Month for their exceptional and continuous contributions to our citizens.
