RE: Coastal Resource Enhancement Fund (CREF) 2014 Cycle

Continued Hearing of March 4, 2014

At the Board of Supervisors hearing on February 18, 2014, Planning and Development (P&D) presented its staff recommendations for the 2014 CREF awards, and CREF applicants and the public presented their proposals and comments. At that hearing, each Board member presented his/her preliminary thoughts on the CREF proposals and staff's funding recommendations.

Your Board agreed with most of staff's recommendations, but did express an interest in funding at least a portion of both the Dunes Center and Santa Barbara Maritime Museum proposals. Your Board also expressed concern with funding of the City of Lompoc's Santa Ynez River Bank Stabilization Project, stating that it may be premature and that critical matching funds had not yet been awarded.

To assist your Board in its decision making process, staff has prepared the attached table which identifies each CREF proposal, the amount requested, staff's funding recommendations, a funding option that reflects your Board's discussions from the February 18 hearing, and the funding difference between staff recommendations and the Board option.
