## RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION FOR CUSTODY DEPUTY, SPECIAL DUTY SERGIO JOHN MARTINEZ UPON HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE

**WHEREAS**, Sergio John Martinez will be retiring from County service on Sunday, March 30, 2014, having faithfully served the County of Santa Barbara for more than thirty (30) years; and

**WHEREAS**, Sergio John Martinez started his career with the Probation Department on June 18, 1984, as a Juvenile Institution Officer. He worked with the Probation Department until April of 1998. During his tenure, he served as a Supervising Jail Institution Officer at the Los Prietos Boys Camp; Deputy Probation Officer assigned to the Intensive Supervision Unit; and finally as a Supervisor Deputy Probation Officer in Lompoc; and

**WHEREAS**, Sergio John Martinez continued County service by joining the Sheriff's Office as a Corrections Officer. In 2002, he promoted to Corrections Officer, Special Duty. During his fifteen (15) years of service, he worked in various capacities, most notably as a Custody Deputy, Special Duty with the Classification Unit, where he provided crucial training and jail intelligence; and

**WHEREAS**, Sergio John Martinez provided the citizens and the employees of Santa Barbara County extraordinary professionalism and insightful correctional service, while dedicating his life to the pursuit of peace, justice, and happiness; and

**WHEREAS**, Sergio John Martinez's knowledge, skills, and experience contributed greatly to the overall professionalism and the guiding principles of the Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Office, as well as the objectives of the County of Santa Barbara.

**NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED** that this Board of Supervisors commends Sergio John Martinez for his faithful and distinguished service to the citizens of Santa Barbara County, congratulates him upon his retirement, and wishes him continued good health and many years of happiness.
