REVISED EMERGENCY PERMIT

January 24, 2005

- Permit No.: 4-05-005-G (Revised from January 21, 2005 permit)
- Applicant: Santa Barbara County Parks
- Agent: Coleen Lund, Santa Barbara County Parks
- **Project Location:** Goleta Beach County Park, 5986 Sandspit Road, Goleta (Santa **Barbara County**)
- Work Proposed: Installation of approximately 1,000 tons of rock at a 1:1 to 1:1.5 slope along 350 linear feet of the beach at the base of the parking area. The project includes trenching to a depth of approximately 2 to 3 feet at the toe of the rock structure. The source of the rock are storage yards in Goleta and Cambria. Additional construction of a 650-foot long sand berm will occur at the base of the park's lawn, east of the rock structure. Two loaders and excavators will be used for construction. Construction will occur during low tidal periods.

This letter constitutes approval of the emergency work you or your representative has requested to be done at the location listed above. I understand from the information submitted that an unexpected occurrence in the form of loss of beach and lawn area has arisen as a result of high tides and storm swells. A parking area, restroom, picnic tables, trees, and lawn at Goleta Beach are threatened by the encroaching loss of land. These occurrences require immediate action to prevent or mitigate loss or damage to life, health, property or essential public services. 14 Cal. Admin. Code Section 13009. The Executive Director hereby finds that:

- (a) An emergency exists which requires action more quickly than permitted by the procedures for administrative or ordinary permits and the development can and will be completed within 30 days unless otherwise specified by the terms of the permit;
- (b) Public comment on the proposed emergency action has been reviewed if time allows: and

The work is hereby approved, subject to the conditions listed on the reverse.

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

- 1. The enclosed form must be signed by the applicant and returned to our office within fifteen (15) days.
- 2. Only that work specifically described above and for the specific property listed above is authorized. Any additional work requires separate authorization from the Executive Director.
- 3. The work authorized by this permit must be completed within thirty (30) days of the date of this permit.
- 4. In exercising this permit, the applicant agrees to hold the California Coastal Commission harmless from any liabilities for damage to public or private properties or personal injury that may result from the project.
- 5. The work authorized by this emergency permit is temporary, unless permanent retention of the development is authorized through the issuance of a regular Coastal Development Permit from the California Coastal Commission. Within sixty (60) days of the date of this permit, the permittee shall submit a complete application for a regular coastal development permit to have the emergency work be considered permanent. If no such application is received, the emergency work shall be removed in its entirety within 120 days of the date of this permit unless waived by the Executive Director.
- 6. This permit does not obviate the need to obtain necessary authorizations and/or permits from other agencies.
- 7. No machinery will be allowed in the subtidal zone at any time. The permittee shall immediately remove from the beach area any and all debris that results from the construction activities.

IMPORTANT

The emergency work is considered to be temporary work done in an emergency situation. If the property owner wishes to have the emergency work become a permanent development, a coastal permit must be obtained. A regular permit would be subject to all of the provisions of the California Coastal Act and may be conditioned accordingly.
