

In 1963, local governments were granted the power to tax the privilege of occupying a room or other living space in a hotel, motel, inn, tourist home, or other lodging (such as campgrounds) for 30 days or less. Transient occupancy tax (TOT), calculated as a percentage of the daily rent, is collected by the operator and then remitted to a city finance department or County Treasurer–Tax Collector for unincorporated areas.

During fiscal year 2012-13 the transient occupancy tax rate was 10% for all unincorporated areas, the City of Santa Maria and the City of Lompoc; and 6% for the City of Guadalupe. During the year, TOT rates increased from 10% to 12% for the cities of Buellton, Carpinteria, Goleta, and Solvang as a result of voter approved ballot measures.

¹ Summary of the County / City Revenue Neutrality Agreement for the City of Goleta:

- Agreement in effect from February 1, 2002 until June 30, 2012.
- 60% of TOT generated in the City of Goleta goes to the City and 40% goes to the County.
- For overnight hospitality establishments that opened after February 1, 2002, 100% of TOT generated in the City of Goleta goes to the City.

Transient occupancy tax reached \$39.88 million in fiscal year 2012-13, an increase of 10.8% from fiscal year 2011-12.

During the prior fiscal year 2011-12, the County received 40% of TOT generated in the City of Goleta, which amounted to \$1.45 million. Due to the termination of the revenue neutrality mitigation period, effective July 1, 2012, the County no longer receives a 40% share of the TOT. This created a significant shift of TOT revenues from the County to the City of Goleta.

Room Sales - FY 2012-13

During fiscal year 2012-13, the lodging industry brought in \$360.3 million in room sales across all cities and County unincorporated areas. This is an increase of 7.9% over FY 2011-12 room sales of \$333.8 million.

Northern Santa Barbara County generated \$79.9 million in the incorporated cities and an additional \$7.7 million in the unincorporated areas. Southern Santa Barbara County generated \$212.6 million in the incorporated areas and an additional \$60.1 million in the unincorporated areas.

The City of Santa Barbara generated the most significant portion of room sales of \$146.8 million - approximately 41% of total countywide sales.

The City of Goleta generated \$51.2 million, 14% of the countywide total.

A significant portion of room sales were also generated in the unincorporated area of Montecito at \$42.3 million, 12% of the countywide total.

The unincorporated area of Goleta generated \$15.2 million, 4%, of total room sales countywide.

Other Economic Benefits of the Hospitality Industry

The data below provides information about various other economic benefits generated as a result of the lodging/ overnight accommodations industry in Santa Barbara County. This includes property tax revenue from hotels/ motels, sales tax revenue generated on accommodations and restaurants, and employment (# jobs provided) within the accommodations sector for fiscal years 2011-12 and 2012-13.





6 Year Annual TOT Revenue Trend—Incorporated and Unincorporated Areas

The economy peaked in December 2007 and over the next 2 years fell to an all time low in FY 2009-10 as a result of the recession. Within Santa Barbara County, the tourism/hospitality industry trended in direct correlation with this economic cycle. Countywide, transient occupancy tax in FY 2007-08 reached \$34.5 million and dropped to \$30.1 million in FY 2009-10 a 5.1% decrease. However, since FY 2009-10, TOT has increased steadily each year, reaching an all time high of \$39.9 million in FY 2012-13, an increase of 10.8% over FY 2011-12.



5 Year Monthly Revenue Trend — Unincorporated Areas and Economic Forecast



This chart demonstrates the cyclical nature of TOT revenues in Santa Barbara County. High season for TOT revenues begins in June, increases further in July and peaks in the month of August.

Looking forward to future years, when considering the recovery over the past 3 years, our expectation is that revenues will continue to increase annually by 4%.
