Government Code (GC) section 76104.6 became effective November 3, 2004. It directs California Courts to levy a \$1 penalty for every \$10 or fraction thereof upon every fine, penalty and forfeiture levied on criminal offenses including traffic offenses, but excluding parking offenses, to implement the *DNA Fingerprint, Unsolved Crime and Innocence Protection Act* (Proposition 69). The revenues from this penalty are deposited in the *DNA Identification Fund* established in each county's treasury. Monies in the fund are divided quarterly between the State and the County pursuant to GC 76104.6. Each county is directed to report to the Legislature and the Department of Justice, by April 1 of each year, on the total amount of fines: (1) collected, (2) allocated and (3) expended for each authorized program in the preceding calendar year.
