AMENDMENT TO MEASURE A

PROJECT COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

For project awarded to County of Santa Barbara in Cycle 1 of the Measure A Bicycle and Pedestrian and Safe Routes to School Programs

This Amended Cooperative Agreement ("Amended Agreement") is entered into by and between the County of Santa Barbara ("Sponsor") and the SANTA BARBARA COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS, acting as the Santa Barbara County Local Transportation Authority ("Authority") and collectively referred to as "the Parties."

Whereas on April 19, 2012, the parties entered into the Measure A Project Cooperative Agreement ("Cooperative Agreement") to facilitate Authority providing funds to Sponsor for eligible Measure A projects.

Whereas, Authority allows extension of Timely Use of Funds Deadlines due to extraordinary or unforeseen circumstances, per the program guidelines.

Whereas, the Parties wish to make a technical amendment to the indemnification clause of the Cooperative Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and undertakings herein made and the mutual benefits to be derived therefrom, the Parties hereto hereby agree to amend the Cooperative Agreement as follows:

- 1. Attachment D is Amended as follows:
 Timely Use of Funds Deadline: 6/30/2014 6/30/2015
- 2. Section 3.3.a is Amended as follows: "Sponsor shall defend, indemnify, and save harmless the Authority, its officers, agents and employees from any and all claims, demands, damages, costs, expenses (including attorney's fees), judgments or liabilities arising out of this Agreement or occasioned by the performance or attempted performance of the provisions hereof; including, but not limited to, any act or omission to act on the part of the Sponsor or its agents or employees or other independent contractors directly responsible to it; except those claims, demands, damages, costs, expenses (including attorney's fees), judgments or liabilities resulting solely from the negligence or willful misconduct of the Sponsor- Authority."
- 3. Section 3.3.b. is Amended as follows: "Authority shall defend, indemnify and save harmless the Sponsor, its officers, agents and employees from any and all claims, demands, damages, costs, expenses (including attorney's fees), judgments or liabilities arising out of this Agreement or occasioned by the performance or attempted performance of the provisions hereof; including, but not limited to, any act or omission to act on the part of the Authority or its agents or employees or other independent contractors directly responsible to it; except those claims, demands,

damages, costs, expenses (including attorney's fees), judgments or liabilities resulting solely from the negligence or willful misconduct of the Authority Sponsor."

4. In all other respects, this Cooperative Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
