Background

Voluntary, free program created in 1995

Innovative Building Review Program (IBRP)

 Updated concurrently with Title 24 and CALGreen standards



Program Incentives

- Development benefits
 - Increased marketability
 - Increased comfort
 - Reduced utility bills
- Reduction in plan check fees
- Expedited plan check review process
- Resolution of
 Commendation



Program Updates

- Name change of program
 - Smart Build Santa Barbara (SB²)
- Two tier structure
 - Ultra Low Energy Verified
 - Exceed Title 24 by 30%
 - Zero Net Energy
 - I 00% of energy use met using onsite renewables
 - Exceed Title 24 by 40%
- Updated building standards to reflect CALGreen and Title 24



Energy Element Amendment

- Remove detail regarding tiers
- Update tiers to reflect changes in building design and legislation
- Eliminate need to amend
 Comprehensive Plan any
 time staff updates Program



Recommended Actions

- Find that this amendment is exempt pursuant to Section I 506 I (b)(3) of the State Guidelines for Implementation of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and Notice of Exemption
- Make the findings for approval of the proposed
 Comprehensive Plan amendment, including CEQA findings
- Adopt a Resolution approving Case No. 14GPA-00000-00005 amending Policy 2.1, Policy 2.4, and Policy 6.1 of the Santa Barbara County Comprehensive Plan Energy Element
