- SB1022 Complex will be a 52,208 sq. ft. facility adding 228 rated beds to the Northern Branch Jail
- Programming focused on rehabilitation, including achievement of sobriety and successful reentry into the community
- S.T.A.R Complex will include:
 - Expanded Sheriff's Treatment Program
 - Step-down housing units
 - Specially designed transition housing units
 - Relocation of Alternative Sentencing Bureau
