The new/replacement restroom and shower facility will be a single story structure of less than 1.960 square feet constructed of durable materials and placed in an expanded footprint of the existing shower facility. Minor grading and trenching will occur to accommodate the new restroom and shower facility. Existing mature landscaping will be protected in-place.

New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures, because the size of the new shower and restroom facility is less than 2,500 square feet, does not involve the use of [significant amounts of] hazardous substances, and all required utility services are currently present. The new facility will be located in the expanded footprint of the existing facility. While the border area of the 40 acre Live Oak Campground contains areas of sensitivity, the immediate area where restroom is to be located does not, is well disturbed and has been for decades. The area around the new/replacement restroom is already disturbed, utilities already exist underground in the area and the project limits will contain
the new ground disturbance.
