PERMIT APPROVAL:

This is to inform you that an Emergency Permit has been approved for:

The temporary installation of safety fencing along the bluff top of six (6) County of Santa Barbara and/or Isla Vista Parks & Recreation District parks and/or open space areas along Del Playa Drive in the Community of Isla Vista, Third Supervisorial District. The temporary safety fencing shall be a maximum of 5 feet in height, and located along the top of the ocean bluff of each location to prevent public access to the hazardous bluff areas and to prevent accidental falls. No impacts to existing coastal access points would result from the installation of the temporary safety fencing.

The proposed temporary installation of bluff top safety fencing is a result of several deaths and serious injuries over the past several years resulting from accidental falls from the ocean bluff parcels along Del Playa Drive. The proposed temporary safety fencing installation is a joint effort of the University of California Santa Barbara (UCSB), County of Santa Barbara, and Isla Vista Recreation and Park District to mitigate the hazardous condition at the sites where no bluff fencing, or only low fencing exists while a permanent solution is formalized. The installation of the temporary safety fencing is urgently needed to protect the life of Isla Vista residents and the large number of visitors to the community expected for the upcoming UCSB graduation ceremonies.

Therefore, in the interest of public safety, this situation constitutes an emergency in accordance with the applicable zoning ordinance indicated above and immediate action is warranted. As the required findings (listed below) can be made, the emergency work is hereby approved, subject to compliance with the attached conditions of approval. This permit is not valid until signed by the owner/applicant and subsequently issued by the Planning and Development Department upon verification that all conditions of approval requiring action prior to permit issuance are satisfied.

EMERGENCY PERMIT CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

1. This Emergency Permit is based upon and limited to compliance with the project description, and the conditions of approval set forth below. Any deviations from the project description or conditions must be reviewed and approved by the County for conformity with this approval. Deviations without the above-described approval will constitute a violation of permit approval. If it is determined that project activity is occurring in violation of any or all of the following conditions, the Director of Planning and Development may revoke this permit and all authorization for development. The decision of the Director to revoke the Emergency Permit may be appealed to the Planning Commission.

The project description is as follows:

The temporary installation of safety fencing along the bluff top of six (6) County of Santa Barbara and/or Isla Vista Parks & Recreation District parks and/or open space areas along Del Play Drive in the Community of Isla Vista, Third Supervisorial District. The project involves the following locations:

The temporary safety fencing shall be a maximum of 5 feet in height, and located along the top of the ocean bluff of each location to prevent public access to the hazardous bluffs areas and to prevent accidental falls. No impacts to existing coastal access points would result from the installation of the temporary safety fencing.

- 2. An application for the required permit necessary to validate the emergency work as permanent shall be submitted by the applicant to the Planning and Development Department no later than 30 days following the issuance of this Emergency Permit. The permit required for the proposed emergency work includes a Coastal Development Permit with Hearing pursuant to Section 35-169 of the Article II Coastal Zoning Ordinance.
- 3. Any materials required for a completed application, as identified in the initial review of the original application required pursuant to Condition #2 above, shall be submitted within 90 days after written notification of the application deficiencies is provided to the applicant. This time period may be extended by the Director of Planning and Development.
- 4. Only that emergency work specifically requested and deemed an emergency for the specific property mentioned is authorized. Any additional emergency work requires separate authorization from the Director of Planning and Development.

- 5. This permit does not preclude the necessity to obtain authorization and/or permits from other County Departments or other agencies.
- The Director of Planning and Development may order the work authorized under this emergency 6. permit to stop immediately if it is determined that unanticipated and substantial adverse environmental effects may occur with continued construction.
