Per the July 1, 2014 hearing, the recommended actions have been revised as follows:

Revised Recommended Actions for Inland Project, 13CUP-00000-00009:

- 1. Deny the appeal (Case No. 14APL-00000-00016);
- 2. Make the required findings to deny the project, included as Attachment 1 of this Memorandum dated July 8, 2014, including CEQA findings;
- 3. Determine the project denial to be exempt from CEQA pursuant to Guideline Section 15270;
- 4. Deny the project (Case No. 13CUP-00000-00009) thereby affirming *de novo* the decision of the Montecito Planning Commission; and
- 5. Waive the Notice of Exemption 6-day posting requirement for good cause pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section V.D.2 and direct staff to prepare a Notice of Exemption.

- 4. Deny the project (Case Nos. 13CUP-00000-00010 and 14CDP-00000-00002) thereby affirming *de novo* the decision of the Montecito Planning Commission; and
- 5. Waive the Notice of Exemption 6-day posting requirement for good cause pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section V.D.2 and direct staff to prepare a Notice of Exemption.
