## **Mission Canyon Pilot Project**

We are delighted to be involved in the Mission Canyon Pilot Project and are pleased to provide the Santa Barbara County Fire Department with all of the equipment required for the Pilot Project, as a donation.

## The equipment includes the following components:

- Nine (9) FlameSniffer 4C-V5 sensor units featuring 360-degree thermal and visual imaging, flame, CO2 and smoke detection and ultrasonic weather conditions. All units shall be supplied with Power-line infrastructure brackets, solar panels and all required hardware.
- Two (2) FlameSniffer Communication Hubs
- Two (2) FlameSniffer Base Stations to be located at the Public Safety Dispatch Center and Santa Barbara County Fire Department Station 15, respectively.
- Complete 24 hour secured access to the FlameSniffer Command Center General User Interface for management of alerts, sensor unit access and all data provided by the units.
