




- Undergrounded, placed in pedestal, or slimlined the BBUs

Staff:


- Require MBAR review of warning stickers, slimline housing, innovative screening of power pedestals, slimmer BBUs, equipment consolidation.

Proposed Slimline BBU







Photo simulation of MON11 BBU
