Suicide is a public health problem, and suicide prevention is a community responsibility; and WHEREAS, September is National and International Suicide Prevention Awareness Month

and WHEREAS, worldwide there are more deaths by suicide than by homicide and war combined;

deaths by suicide in our country; and WHEREAS, in the United States, one person dies by suicide every 13.3 minutes, with 39,518

WHEREAS, in our country, suicide is the 3rd leading cause of death for 15-24 year olds, and is leading cause of death for people of all ages; and

premature death, according to the Santa Barbara County Public Health Department Statistic; and WHEREAS, in Santa Barbara County suicide was reported as the 5th leading cause of


over 200,000 newly bereaved each year; and WHEREAS, each person's death by suicide intimately affects at least six other people, with
