Summary Text:

The Laguna County Sanitation District provides wastewater services primarily for the Orcutt and unincorporated Santa Maria area. New development is typically conditioned to design and construct sewer system facilities that will be dedicated to the local public sewer agency for ownership and maintenance purposes. Design standards and development policies are adopted and periodically updated to reflect changes in standards, regulations, conditions and policy.

Background:

Laguna County Sanitation District currently owns and operates approximately 129 miles of sewer lines and one lift station. Much of this infrastructure was designed and constructed by development. The proposed *Laguna County Sanitation District Standard Specifications for the Construction of Sanitary Sewers* updates design and construction specifications for new development as well as policies and procedures regarding annexation, conditions of approval, and incorporates new ordinances.
