Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors consider recommendations regarding amending the Dental Services Agreement with the Community Health Centers of the Central Coast as follows:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the Second Amendment to the Dental In-Kind Services Agreement with the Community Health Centers of the Central Coast for the period of November 1, 2014 to June 30, 2016 for County patients referred to the Community Health Centers of the Central Coast dental facilities in Lompoc and Santa Maria.
- b) Authorize the Public Health Department Director or designee to revise and update the Dental In-Kind Services Agreement as necessary to provide access to needed dental services for eligible County patients if those changes do not impact the value of the agreement or conflict with the linked Lease Agreement for the Cuyama Clinic.
- c) Determine that these activities are exempt from California Environmental Quality Act review per CEQA Guideline Section 15061(b)(3), since it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activities may have a significant effect on the environment.

Second Amendments to In-Kind Dental Services Agreement with Community Health Centers of the Central Coast

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Summary Text:

This item is on the Board agenda to execute the Second Amendment of the In-Kind Dental Services Agreement with the Community Health Centers of the Central Coast (CHCCC). The In-Kind Dental Services Agreement is linked as a bartering arrangement to the Lease Agreement for the County owned Cuyama Clinic whereby a value of \$25,000 in free dental services is available to eligible PHD patients at CHCCC dental clinics in Lompoc and Santa Maria in exchange for free rent. Approval of this Second Amendment will update available dental services to reflect changes to Denti-Cal in California and will make available additional services to improve access for eligible patients.

The County's Public Health Department (PHD) and CHCCC have similar missions regarding the health and well-being of Santa Barbara residents. PHD has been in communication with CHCCC and the parties have identified where additional routine and preventative dental services are needed to better serve current and future PHD patients. Approval this Second Amendment will have no effect on the exchange of free rent at the County-owned Cuyama Clinic.

Authorization of the Public Health Director or his designee to update or revise this agreement in the future without Board Approval will allow the Director to make similar changes to adjust services as necessary to comply with changing procedure designations in State Denti-Cal or to expand access for PHD patients.

Background:

Since inception of this unique arrangement of the exchange of lease of County property for free dental services in May of 2012, the Public Health Department has received more than 1300 free dental services for over 220 patients. The Community Health Centers of the Central Coast report providing twenty to twenty four hours of clinic services per week (Monday, Wednesday and Fridays) are averaging approximately 260 medical visits and 180 dental visits annually and are providing health education and outreach to the community at public events and through their nurse home visits.

Approval and execution of this Second Amendment to the In-Kind Dental Services Agreement will allow PHD and CHCCC to expand the number and types of dental procedures provided to PHD patients.
