Recommended Amendments to the Santa Barbara County Code



Overview of Recommendations

 General clean-up and update of language to reflect current terms:

Examples:

- ✓ Animal Shelter vs. pound
- ✓ *Euthanasia* vs. destruction
- Add definitions
- Eliminate references to obsolete committee (committee was removed by the Board of Supervisors in 1982)
- Clarify rabies quarantine requirements



Dangerous Dogs

- Expanded definitions to include
 - Potentially Dangerous
 - ✓ Vicious
- Allows Hearing Officer discretion on conditions for release of dogs

Examples:

- Pen/enclosure design and requirements
- ✓ Muzzle in public
- Training program
- ✓ Insurance
- Language does not require euthanasia of all dangerous dogs



Conclusion

- Amendments will help the continued promotion of responsible pet ownership.
 - ✓ Scoop that Poop!
- Public safety will be taken into consideration as revised dangerous dog article is implemented.
- Administrative guidelines will be developed for Hearing Officers .
- Recommendations conform to current California law and trends in animal care and control programs.
