

I am interested in serving on the Santa Barbara County Historic Landmarks Advisory Committee because I have a strong interest in cultural heritage and historic preservation. I believe in the principle that recognition and preservation of significant historical buildings, structures, sites, and places enriches the cultural, historical, and economic fabric of our county.

As a ten-year resident and homeowner in Santa Barbara County, I feel that I can serve my community by being a steward, leader, and advocate for our historically significant landmarks. I am enthusiastic and curious about history, architecture, and preservation. The potential to have a positive impact in shaping the rich cultural heritage and landmark history of Santa Barbara County is very exciting!

My most relevant qualification stems from completing the USC School of Architecture Heritage Conservation course. The course was designed for a broad swath of students, design professionals, community leaders, preservationists, planners and developers seeking a greater understanding of heritage conservation. The topics covered included the basic concepts, guidelines and methods currently employed for historic preservation, rehabilitation and restoration of cultural artifacts, buildings, districts and landscapes in the US. Specifically, the coursework delved into the following components:

- Secretary of Interior Standards for preservation/rehabilitation/restoration:
- The legal strategies for protecting historic resources in California, including federal, state and local preservation policies and legislation;
- Processes and procedures around Section 106 reviews, CEQA, EIRs;
- Crafting effective local historic preservation ordinances;
- Conservation economics, including tax credit programs, adaptive reuse ordinances and other incentive programs

Additionally, I earned my Bachelor of Arts degree in Geography and Political Science and a minor in History from the University of California, Santa Barbara. I focused much of my studies on the history of and cultural and physical geography of California. I'm also an avid reader of the many books published by California's Historian, Kevin Starr, as well as Santa Barbara historian, Walker Tompkins.

While completing my degree at UCSB I had the special opportunity to intern at the Library of Congress, Geography and Map Division, which houses the world's largest collection of maps, globes and atlases. I had the special privilege of spending countless hours within the massive collection, specifically searching through historically significant Santa Barbara County maps.

I am a longtime supporter and member of the Los Angeles Conservancy. The Conservancy has taught me the importance of being an advocate for cultural heritage and historic preservation.

While I do have much to learn, I think I can bring a fresh perspective and enthusiasm to the HLAC. I appreciate the opportunity to apply and hope I have the opportunity to serve my community through the HLAC.
