Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the attached Comcast Enterprise Services -Master Services Agreement, including the First Amendment to the Agreement, with Comcast Business Communications LLC for non-exclusive Ethernet Network Services for a five year
- b) Authorize the Director of General Services or designee to approve Sales Orders under the Comcast Enterprise Services - Master Services Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$300,000; and
- c) Determine that the proposed project is exempt from the provisions of CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301, as it involves the operation and maintenance of County equipment that will result in no or negligible expansion of existing use.

Summary Text:

General Services is proposing to enter into a five year Master Services Agreement (MSA) with Comcast Business Communications LLC to provide Ethernet Network Services (ENS) for data connectivity between County facilities located primarily in Northern areas of Santa Barbara County.

In May 2004, the County of Santa Barbara entered into a contractual agreement with Comcast of Santa Maria L.L.C. which provided a seven year cable communications system franchise including an

Institutional Network Service Agreement (I-Net). Comcast created a data network infrastructure that connected 16 sites for the purpose of computer based data communications. In May 2011, the County's cable communications franchise agreement with Comcast of Santa Maria LLC expired. Since May 2011, Comcast has continued to provide services as defined in the 2004 franchise agreement. General Services conducted a comprehensive review of data communication providers in the Northern Santa Barbara County, searching for best pricing and service level options. Because Comcast was and is the only vendor that already has a presence at each site and Comcast is the only vendor prepared to offer high speed broadband connectivity, General Services determined that Comcast is uniquely positioned to service the County connectivity needs.

Background:

In May 2004, the County of Santa Barbara entered into a contractual agreement with Comcast of Santa Maria L.L.C. which provided a seven year cable communications system franchise including an Institutional Network Service Agreement (I-Net). The franchise agreement provided for a regional high bandwidth network.

In 2006, California's Digital Infrastructure and Video Competition Act was enacted. The Act established a statewide franchising procedure for video service providers to be administered by the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and preempted local government franchising authority where a state franchise has been acquired.

In May 2011, the County's cable communications franchise agreement with Comcast of Santa Maria LLC expired. Since May 2011, Comcast has continued to provide services as defined in the 2004 franchise agreement. During that time the County of Santa Barbara and Comcast entered into and completed service level negotiations.

General Services conducted a comprehensive review of data communication providers in the Northern areas of Santa Barbara County, searching for best pricing and service level options. Because Comcast has a presence at each site, General Services determined that at this point in time, Comcast is uniquely positioned to service our connectivity needs through this MSA. A single data communication provider is preferred for high reliability and customer service issues.

There are increased costs for this new service model. General Services is responsible for funding the intercampus links through cost allocation to the Departments and collects funds for connectivity in the annual rate structure. Departments are responsible for remote location connectivity costs. General Services representing the Departments needs at the facilities, worked with Comcast to determine the best form of connectivity for each County remote location. The monthly costs for each location were projected and are budgeted by departments for fiscal year 2014-2015. See Attachment C for projected annual charges.

Through the use of the MSA, departments are able to add and delete service sites and adjust service levels as business needs change. The Director of General Services or designee will approve all Sales Orders processed through the MSA.

Achieve a five percent reduction in network outages from the previous year.

Narrative:

The expenses associated for this connectivity are budgeted in Fiscal Year 2014-2015. General Services has budgeted \$21,552 in the current fiscal year and is responsible for funding the intercampus links. Countywide, General Fund departments budgeted \$13,056 in the current fiscal year for remote location costs. Countywide, "Other Funds Departments" budgeted \$41,070 in the current fiscal year for remote

Key Contract Risks:

Because this contract represents a renewal of our service agreement with Comcast the risks of service disruption are reduced. However, every effort will be made to plan equipment upgrades and replacements during non-business hours to reduce the impact of any outage.
