Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

Approve the appointments, in lieu of election, of qualified individuals to Special District Boards of Directors as reflected in the List of Appointments by Special District.

Background:

On September 16, 2014, the Board of Supervisors was asked by the County Elections Official to appoint in lieu of election those Special District Board Members who had filed the required nomination papers and qualified for the positions. The Board acted on this request and appointed 41 individuals to Special District Boards throughout the County. This hearing was conducted pursuant to Section 10515 of the Elections Code.

In addition, the Board was informed of eight Special District Boards that have one or more vacancies where no candidates had filed nomination papers. Your Board directed staff to initiate outreach efforts in order to locate qualified individuals interested in serving on these Special District Boards. Staff engaged in the following:

- a) Contacted and worked with the individual Special Districts in order to ascertain if currently serving District members or District staff were aware of any qualified individuals who would be interested in serving;

- b) As necessary, published display advertising seeking qualified individuals for the positions; and
- c) Coordinated outreach with the appropriate Board Office(s) to identify individuals who may be interested in serving.

Given the importance of the services provided by Local Special Districts, a critical concern is the availability of a voting quorum (at least three Board members) for each District. The List of Vacancies as provided by the Santa Barbara County Elections is included as Attachment B. Staff has received 9 applications or letters of interest (Attachment C) for the 15 vacant Special District positions.

Should the Board choose to appoint all of the applicants reflected in Attachment A, the following Special Districts Boards will have all available seats filled:

- i) Cuyama Valley Recreation District – Five Members
- ii) Cuyama Valley Community Services District – Five Members
- iii) Los Alamos Community Services District – Five Members
- iv) Santa Maria Valley Water Conservation District – Seven members representing Divisions 1 through 7
- v) Santa Ynez River WCD, Improvement District #1, Division #2 – Five Members

The following Special District Board will have three of five members:

- i) Casmalia Community Services District – Three Members

The Casmalia Community Services Districts will have a working quorum with three members; however, an additional two appointments would need to be made per the provisions of the Elections Code for these Special Districts to have a full Board of five members.

Regarding the Santa Rita Hills Community Services District, staff had previously conducted an extensive outreach seeking individuals interested in serving on the Santa Rita Hills Community Services District Board. This effort included working with the General Manager of the District, targeted display advertising and contacting individually, every registered voter of the District. Staff received no response from any individual eligible to serve on the Board.

The appointed candidates will take office on December 5, 2014; therefore, these appointments must be finalized prior to that date.






