WHEREAS, the County of Santa Barbara is committed to ensuring that all teens are apprised and knowledgeable of their rights to a healthy relationship by supporting Domestic Violence Solutions mission; and

WHEREAS, Domestic Violence Solutions for Santa Barbara County works to end intergenerational cycle of violence by providing prevention and intervention with teens through the Teen Outreach Program, and challenges society's attitudes, beliefs and behaviors to effect social change.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors recognizes February Teen Dating Violence Awareness and Prevention Month in Santa Barbara, and urges all members of the community to educate themselves on the rights and responsibilities relating to healthy relationships in celebration of this observance.
