WHEREAS, Gabriel was selected for the CHS President's Award during grades 9, 10 and 11, was selected Co-Student of the Month in October 2014, named as a Tri-Valley League Honorable Mention for Football in 2013, and Tri-Valley League Honorable Mention for Track & Field, including Discus in 2014; and

WHEREAS, Gabriel is a highly motivated individual who volunteered his time and energy to maintain the field for the girls CHS softball team, worked at the annual Carpinteria Relay for Life, parked cars at CHS during AvoFest, served as an assistant basketball coach for Special Olympics and delivered gifts during the holidays to those in need through a local church sponsored program;
