Proposed Amendments

If adopted, amendments will:

- 1. Provide an ability to collect enforcement staff costs;
- Provide an appeal process to dispute staff costs;
- 3. Provide an ability to file tax liens on unpaid final staff costs (after potential appeal)



Chapter 35 - Appeal Rights

County LUDC - Section 35.108.070 - Recovery of Costs

E. Hearing on Objections:

"Any property owner...who receives a summary of costs... shall have a right to a hearing before the Director on their objections."

- 1. A request for a hearing shall be filed within 10 days;
- A hearing shall be held on the owner's objections within 30 days;
- 3. Unpaid costs shall be recoverable via tax lien.

Recommended Amendments:

If adopted:

- 1. P&D will issue periodic billing statements to owners on enforcement related charges;
- 2. Property owner will have a right to contest the charges billed;
- 3. P&D Director will hold a hearing on charges within 30 days of receiving the appeal;
- 4. Unpaid final order may be collected pursuant to Gov Code § 54988, et seq. (tax lien)
