WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of public safety that certain portions of County streets or highways in Santa Barbara County be designated with parking restrictions in accordance with said Sections.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the following locations in Santa Barbara County and under the jurisdiction of the Board of Supervisors of said County are hereby designated as:

No Stopping, Standing or Parking Zones

- On the east side of San Antonio Road from the centerline of Calle Real to a point 920 feet north of the centerline of Calle Real.
- On the west side of San Antonio Road from the centerline of Calle Real to a point 150 feet north of the centerline of Calle Real.
- On both sides of Burton Mesa Boulevard (north) from the centerline of Constellation Road to the centerline of Clubhouse Road.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Santa Barbara County Director of Public Works or designee is hereby authorized and directed to designate said locations with appropriate markings and/or signs as time and resources permit.
