A BARBARA RESOLUTION HONORING DAN EIDELSON FOR HIS SERVICE ON THE MONTECITO BOARD OF TRORNIA

WHEREAS, Dan Eidelson has served with distinction as a member of the Montecito Planning Commission (MPC) since 2009 and was the 2014 Chair: and

WHEREAS, during his service on the MPC, Dan Eidelson provided valuable insight, perspective and leadership on a number of important issues to the Montecito community which included: cellular transmission towers, funding for an update to the Montecito design guidelines, and the San Ysidro pedestrian pathway; and

WHEREAS, Dan Eidelson was an instrumental advocate for the creation of both the MPC and Montecito Board of Architectural Review (MBAR) in 2003. His resolve and ability to work with the Montecito community and the County of Santa Barbara to bring the MPC and MBAR to fruition has led to enhanced local control and input into the planning process; and

WHEREAS, Dan Eidelson has been a resident of Montecito since 1976 during which time he has volunteered his time and energy to preserve the semi-rural character of Montecito and enhance the quality of life for all residents. His service includes: past president of the Montecito Association; past president of the Montecito Foundation; past president of the Montecito Sanitary District; Vector Control Board; Montecito Fire Protection District Board; a member fof the County Redevelopment Dissolution Oversight Committee; and as a Parade Judge for the Montecito Village Parade since inception; and

WHEREAS, Dan Eidelson was honored as the 2002 Montecito Association Citizen of the Year for his volunteerism and community service. In addition the numerous Boards and Commissions he served on, he volunteered for Transition House, the Santa Barbara Rape Crisis Center, Child Abuse Listening and Mediation, and he constructed the back porch deck on the Montecito Community Hall & Library;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors Dan Eidelson for his service as a member of the Montecito Planning Commission and further commends him for his dedication to enhancing the quality of life for all residents of Montecito and Santa Barbara County.
