WHEREAS, Sam Maphis served with distinction as an original member of the Montecito Board of Architectural Review (MBAR) from 2003-2015, including as Chair from January 28, 2013 thru January 5, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Sam Maphis provided valuable insight, a thoughtful perspective and exemplary leadership throughout his service on the MBAR. During his tenure, Sam was instrumental in enhancing outcomes for a number of important issues and projects including: Westmont's Master Plan; the Miramar; the Music Academy of the West; the Coral Casino; Crown Castle; San Ysidro Village; and numerous individual homes; and

WHEREAS, prior to his service on the MBAR, Sam Maphis served on the Montecito Association's Architectural Review Committee where he worked to review projects to ensure they upheld the Montecito Community Plan and that the unique character of Montecito was protected; and

WHEREAS, Sam Maphis is the founder of Earthform Design, based in Santa Barbara since 1980, where he has worked in the field of master land planning and urban site design for high-end residential, commercial projects and institutional projects as well as large scale land development, urban design, restoration and community development projects;
