
Senate Bill 128 Death with Dignity

March 24, 2015



SB 128 Summary

- Proposed bill would enact the End of Life Option Act
- Would authorize a terminally ill adult, meeting specific qualifications, to request end of life medication
- Patient must be terminally ill, competent, voluntarily requesting, and a California resident.

Recommended Actions



- A. Take an advocacy position of support, watch, or oppose on SB 128 (Wolk and Monning): Division of the Health and Safety Code, relating to end of life; and
- B. Direct staff to forward, and authorize the Chair to sign a letter stating the Board's decision to the legislative author, members of the legislature including, but not limited to, the county legislative delegation, and appropriate committee chairs; and

Option 2:

A. Take no position on SB 128 (Wolk and Monning):
 Division of the Health and Safety Code, relating to end of life;
