
Assembly Bill 226 Fisherman's Markets

AB 226 Summary



- Legislative Committee had a positive recommendation
- Proposed law would provide similar regulations of certified Farmer's Markets
- Current law only allows fisherman to sell to the public "directly from the boat"
- Streamline permitting process
- Environmental Health would inspect, permit fees should offset costs



Recommended Actions



Option 1:

- A. Take an advocacy position of support, watch, or oppose on AB 226 (Atkins) Retail Food Safety: Fisherman's Markets; and
- B. Direct staff to forward, and authorize the Chair to sign a letter stating the Board's decision to the legislative author, members of the legislature including, but not limited to, the county legislative delegation, and appropriate committee chairs; and Option 2:
 - A. Take no position on AB 226 (Atkins) Retail
 Food Safety: Fisherman's Markets
