



ARROYO BURRO CREEK - PROJECT DETAILS


Acres: 14.7

- 1,400 linear feet along Arroyo Burro Creek
- Opportunity to restore riparian and upland portions of property upon acquisition (Steelhead, Tidewater Goby)
- Provides additional access and open space for the public
- Appraised Fair Market Value: \$4,000,000
