## FOURTH AMENDMENT TO THE INMATE TELEPHONE SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY AND INMATE CALLING SOLUTIONS, LLC, d/b/a ICSOLUTIONS

This Fourth Amendment ("Fourth Amendment") has an effective date of June 6, 2015 ("Fourth Amendment Effective Date") between Santa Barbara County1 ("County2") and Inmate Calling Solutions, LLC, d/b/a ICSolutions. ("ITSP").

WHEREAS, on December 6, 2010, County and ITSP entered into an Inmate Telephone Agreement ("Agreement"); and,

WHEREAS, the Agreement was amended on August 1, 2011, December 6, 2013 and December 6, 2014;

WHEREAS, County and ITSP desire to further amend the Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein, and other good and valuable consideration, County and ITSP hereby agree as follows:

- Section 2 Term is hereby amended to extend the expiration date of the Agreement from June 1. 6, 2015 for a period of six (6) months through December 5, 2015. County, at its sole option, shall have the right to terminate the Agreement at any time during this renewal with sixty (60) days written notice to ITSP without penalty. In the event County exercises such right, all terms and conditions, requirements and specifications in the Agreement shall remain and apply during the renewal term. This Agreement will not automatically renew.
- Except as expressly modified by this Fourth Amendment, the provisions and conditions of 2. the original Agreement, as amended by the First, Second and Third Amendments, are unchanged and shall remain in full force and effect. The original Agreement, as amended and as expressly modified by the First, Second, Third Amendments and this Fourth Amendment, is the complete agreement of the parties and supersedes all prior or contemporaneous agreements and representations, whether written or oral and may not be further modified or amended except by written amendment.
