


Services

- The southern area is on sewer system per RWQCB order in 1983, while northern area remains on septic.
- 818 residences benefit from the sewer system.
- Wastewater is transmitted through City of Santa Barbara collection system for treatment and disposal.



Sewer Service Rates

 A new Joint Powers Agreement approved earlier this year by the County and City improves billing mechanisms:

- Primary City Changes:
 - □ City to bill CSA 12 resident's for use of City infrastructure.

 Sewer bill based on water use with a maximum of \$45.37 per month.

Sewer Service Rates

 A new Joint Powers Agreement approved earlier this year by the County and City improves billing mechanisms:

- Primary County Changes:
 - CSA 12 assessment to fund operations and maintenance costs for the CSA 12 sewer system.
 - □ Property Assessment will be reduced from \$810 annually last year to a proposed \$264 this year.
- Reserve balance approximately \$1.5 million.
