RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING THE MONTH OF OCTOBER 2015 AS ADOPT A SHELTER DOG MONTH IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, dogs are recognized as man's best friend and all animals support the health and well being of their owners; and

**WHEREAS**, the American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (ASPCA) recognizes National Adopt a Shelter Dog Month through education and promotion, nationwide; and

**WHEREAS,** Santa Barbara County Animal Services provides responsible pet ownership education to pet owners in Santa Barbara County about the importance of licensing, vaccinating, spaying and neutering, and micro-chipping their animals; and

**WHEREAS**, nearly 3,500 dogs pass through our Santa Barbara County Animal Services' Shelters every year after being found as stray or surrendered by their owners for various reasons; and

WHEREAS, Santa Barbara County Animal Services works collaboratively with local humane societies and animal rescue groups to promote responsible pet ownership, alleviate shelter overcrowding, and increase adoptions; and

**WHEREAS,** Animal Services realizes that shelter dogs are not broken, useless, or hopeless and shelter dogs are already spayed or neutered, fully vaccinated, and ready to provide unconditional love once adopted.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED** that this Board of Supervisors does hereby recognize the significance of shelter dogs and the importance of National Adopt a Shelter Dog Month and proclaim October 2015 as Adopt a Shelter Dog Month in Santa Barbara County.
