Justification: This budget revision allows the Community Services Department to draw \$24,492 from Fund 0066 HOME Restricted Fund Balance that were not properly

apportioned according to the Rancho Hermosa loan agreement. The fund balance was generated from Rancho Hermosa residual receipts program income in FY 13/14 and FY 14/15. We received two payments totaling \$152,729. Of this amount, \$117,828 was apportioned to Fund 0066 and \$34,901 to Fund 0065. Per the loan agreement, \$93,336 should have been apportioned to Fund 0066 and \$59,393 to Fund 0065. The net affect is \$24,492 from Fund 0066 to Fund

0065.

Justification: The Community Services Department has received a state grant to replace the tracked skid steer loader at Guadalupe Dunes Preserve. The loader will be

used to keep the parking lot clear of sand to provide consistent access for the public. The current piece of equipment is beyond it's useful life, and needs to be

replaced.

The funding will be provided from the California Department of Fish and Wildlife. The project proposal is to maintain and increase visitor services at Rancho Guadalupe Dunes Preserve through public access enhancements. The County will provide an additional \$25K in improvements, such as signage and kiosk improvements, per the agreement as a match to the awarded \$60K. This match amount is already included within the operating budget. According to the recent bid on south county's loader, the equipment cost is estimated at \$65K.
