WHEREAS, an advisory committee on fish and game matters has heretofore not existed in this County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors now finds it advisable to formulate policies and procedures providing for the organization and functioning of said committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara, State of California, as follows:

- That the advisory committee to the Board of Supervisors on fish and game matters be, and it is hereby named the Santa Barbara County Fish and Game Advisory Committee.
- 2. That said Committee be composed of ten members as follows: (a) Five members considered qualified in matters of fish and game, nominated and sponsored by the following organizations:

Federated Sportsmen of Santa Barbara Lompoc Sportsman Association Santa Ynez Valley Sportsmen's Association Santa Maria Valley Sportsmen's Association Cuyama Rod and Gun Club

- (b) One member, considered qualified in matters of fish and game, appointed by each supervisor from within his district.
- Terms of each of the five sportsmen's orangizations'
 members, to be at the pleasure of the Board of
 Directors of the sponsoring organization.

Terms of each of the members appointed by a 1 supervisor, to run concurrently with the term 2 of the appointing supervisor. 3 That said Committee shall elect by majority vote, 4 one member as Chairman and Vice-Chairman for one 5 year, without restriction against re-election. 6 5. That, if after a reasonable period of participation, 7 seven of the ten members consider a member not 8 qualified to serve, or for reasons of extended 9 absences, the Chairman may request either the 10 sponsoring organization or the appointing 11 Supervisor to replace the individual so identified. 12 That said Committee shall meet quarterly on the 13 fourth Thursday of January, April, July, and October, 14 rotating throughout the County as agreed upon. 15 Special meetings may be called by the Chairman when 16 considered necessary, or by request of a simple 17 majority of Committee members. 18 7. That said Committee shall advise the Board of 19 Supervisors on fish and game matters and specifically 20 shall: 21 a. Make recommendations on all applications 22 or proposals of individuals or organi-23 zations for expenditures of fish and game 24 fine revenues. 25 b. Apprise the Board on the current condition 26 of fish and game within the County. 27 c. Recommend projects for the conservation 28 and propagation of fish and game resources 29 within the County. 30 d. Inspect and report on progress of fish and 31

game projects undertaken by the County.

- Furnish the Board adequate notice of the time and place of all said Committee meetings.
- f. Furnish the Board copies of minutes of all meetings of said Committee.
- g. File an annual report with the Board of Supervisors summarizing the activities of the Committee for each fiscal year and setting forth the projects and amounts of monies expended on the same for each fiscal year. Said report shall be filed not later than October 1 of each year.
- h. Review the monthly Controller's report on fine revenues collected by Santa Barbara County courts for infractions of the State Fish and Game Code, and disbursement thereof.
- 8. That the execution of all projects recommended by said Committee and approved by said Board of Supervisors shall be a responsibility of such agency, office, or department as said Board shall direct.
- 9. Any correspondence involving Committee policy, or the stand or position of the Committee on a particular issue, shall be approved by a majority vote of the Committee prior to being used. Exceptions to this would be emergencies that may arise, which will not allow sufficient time to obtain Committee approval. In this case, approval may be obtained from the Chairman, or the Vice-Chairman. This item must then be presented to the entire Committee at the earliest possible time for their review and ratification.

- (c) One member, whose principal source of livelihood is commercial ocean fishing and who is a County resident, to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors.
- 3. Terms of each of the five sportsmen's organizations' members, to be at the pleasure of the Board of Directors of the sponsoring organization. Terms of each of the members appointed by a supervisor, to run concurrently with the term of the appointing supervisor. Term of the commercial ocean fisherman member shall be for two (2) years, commencing January 1, 1983, without restriction against reappointment.
- 4. That said Commission shall elect by a majority vote one member as Chairman and Vice-Chairman for one year, without restriction against re-election.
- 5. That, if after a reasonable period of participation, seven of the eleven members consider a member not qualified to serve, or for reasons of extended absences, the Chairman may request either the sponsoring organization, the appointing Supervisor, or the Board of Supervisors, as the case may be, to replace the individual so identified.
- fourth Thursday of January, April, July and
 October, rotating throughout the County as agreed
 upon. Special meetings may be called by the Chairman
 when considered necessary, or by request of a simple
 majority of Committee members.

- 7. That said Commission shall advise the Board of Supervisors on fish and game matters and specifically shall:
 - a. Make recommendations on all applications or proposals of individuals or organizations for expenditures of fish and game fine revenues.
 - b. Apprise the Board on the current condition of fish and game within the County.
 - c. Recommend projects for the conservation and propagation of fish and game resources within the County.
 - d. Inspect and report on progress of fish and game projects undertaken by the County.
 - e. Furnish the Board adequate notice of the time and place of all said Commission meetings.
 - f. Furnish the Board copies of minutes of all meetings of said Commission.
 - g. Communicate and work with other governmental fish and game agencies, commissions and officials, where appropriate for Santa Barbara fish and game matters.
 - h. Review the monthly Controller's report on fine revenues collected by Santa Barbara County courts for infractions of the State Fish and Game Code, and disbursement thereof."
- 8. That the execution of all projects recommended by said Commission and approved by said Board of Supervisors shall be a responsibility of such agency, office, or department as said Board shall direct.



 - (c) One member, whose principal source of livelihood is commercial ocean fishing and who is a County resident, to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors.
- 2. Terms of each of the six sportsmen's organizations' members, to be at the pleasure of the Board of Directors of the sponsoring organization. Terms of each of the members appointed by a supervisor, to run concurrently with the term of the appointing supervisor. Term of the commercial ocean fisherman member shall be for two (2) years, commencing January 1, 1983, without restrictions against reappointment.
- 3. If after a reasonable period of participation, seven of the twelve members consider a member not qualified to serve, or for reasons of extended absences, the Chairman may request either the sponsoring organization, the appointing Supervisor, or the Board of Supervisors, as the case may be, to replace the individual so identified.
- All appointments to the Santa Barbara County Fish and Game Commissions shall be at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors.
