That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Receive and file the attached minutes of the September 24 and October19, 2015, meetings of the County of Santa Barbara Board of Supervisors Ad hoc Subcommittee and Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Indians, and;
- b) Determine pursuant to CEQA Guideline 15378(b)(5) that the above action is not a project subject to CEQA review because it is an administrative activity that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.

Summary Text:

On August 25, 2015, the Board of Supervisors appointed an a Ad-hoc Subcommittee consisting of Supervisor Farr and Supervisor Adam for the purpose of engaging the Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Indians in discussions related to land use and financial matters of mutual concern that include but are not limited to the Waiver of Sovereign Immunity, Santa Ynez Valley properties of interest inclusive of the Camp 4, Mooney and Escobar, and 350 acre "Triangle" properties and other general topics between the County and the Tribe as appropriate. They further directed staff to draft a letter to the Tribe inviting participation in the process and that two members of the Tribal Business Committee be appointed. In addition the Board of Supervisors directed that appropriate County staff participate including County Counsel, and that the ad-hoc committee meetings be conducted pursuant to the Brown Act and open to the public, and that they are held in a neutral location to encourage participation by Tribal and Non-Tribal individuals. The Ad-hoc Subcommittee and the Tribe have met on three occasions, and are scheduled to meet again on December 10, 2015. The minutes of the September and October meetings
