BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the authorized claim include \$76,179 for SBCAG's regional transportation planning, \$150,000 for County transit and \$111,657 for pedestrian and bicycle facilities, \$1,715,000 for Santa Maria, Lompoc, Solvang and Santa Maria Organization of Transportation Helpers, \$533,348 for County street and road purposes,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments in conjunction with the filing of the claim.
