As a member of the Advisory Working Group and on behalf of the City of Carpinteria, I wish to express my appreciation to Santa Barbara County for taking the lead on the Tri-County Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) feasibility study.

CCA allows local governments to become an energy purveyor and to purchase electrical energy on the wholesale market and establish rates on behalf of their residents, businesses, and municipal accounts.
