Summary Text:

Through this agreement, CDFA reimburses the Santa Barbara County Agricultural Commissioner's Office for the cost of activities that support this ongoing program to conduct annual inspections of licensed wholesale nurseries in Santa Barbara County to ensure they meet the State guidelines for general pest cleanliness and for freedom from pests of quarantine significance.
