# **Recommended Actions:** That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute an agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture to receive reimbursement for the County's Certified Farmer's Market Program for the period of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017 in the amount of \$11,717.00; and
- b) Determine that the above action involves government funding mechanisms and/or fiscal activities and is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15378(b)(4).

### **Summary Text:**

This item is on the agenda for the Board of Supervisors to review and execute an agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) to receive reimbursement for the County Certified Farmers Market (CFM) program. Through this agreement, CDFA will provide reimbursement to the Agricultural Commissioner's Office for the cost associated with the activities that ensure and maintain the quality and wholesomeness of the products offered for sale through the CFM program of Santa Barbara County. It will also help ensure that the selling activities are conducted without fraud, deception, or misrepresentation. This is accomplished through market site inspections, production site inspections and producer and market investigations.

### **Background:**

The Agricultural Commissioner's Office has operated a CFM program for many years and this is the second year that CDFA has made funds available for distribution to County Agricultural Commissioner's Offices. The funding for this program is anticipated to continue to provide reimbursement for our CFM activities.
