## Exhibit A Laguna Sanitation District

### Legal Description

That portion of Rancho Punta de la Laguna in the County of Santa Barbara, State of California, lying Southwesterly of the land deeded to the State of California by Eliza Pauline Elizalde, also known as Eliza Pauline Curletti, recorded July 16, 1948 in Book 793, Page 284 of Official Records, and the quarter corner common to ¼ corner common to Section 6, Township 9 North, Range 34 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian and to Section 1, Township 9 North, Range 35 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian;

Commencing at the Westerly quarter corner of Section 31, Township 10 North, Range 34 West, San Bernardino Meridian, also being the northwesterly most corner of the Laguna Sanitation District formed by Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors' Resolution No. 18598 dated December 29, 1958;

Thence 1) South 00 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East, 5280.00 feet to said quarter corner common to said Section 6 and 1;

Thence 2) South 00 degrees 46 minutes 36 seconds West, 87.26' to the Point of Beginning;

Thence 3) North 51 degrees 30 minutes 30 seconds West, 1754.17 feet;

Thence 4) North 56 degrees 44 minutes 50 seconds West, 602.52 feet;

Thence 5) North 46 degrees 56 minutes 00 seconds West, 551.76 feet;

Thence 6) North 49 degrees 47 minutes 00 seconds West, 366.83 feet;

Thence 7) North 51 degrees 30 minutes 30 seconds West, 778.17 feet to the southeasterly line of the Tract of land allotted and set apart to Ernest C. Graves, by Final Decree of Partition in Santa Barbara County Superior Court Action No. 3255 Entitled "Louisa Elizalde De Quintero, Plaintiff vs. Victoria C. Elizalde, ET AL, Defendants", a certified copy of said decree being recorded December 19, 1896, in Book 58, page 602 of Deeds, Records of said County.

Thence 8) South 36 degrees 15 minutes 00 seconds West, 3095.00 feet to the northeasterly right of way line of the Southern Pacific Railroad as set apart in said final decree;

Thence 9), along said right of way, South 53 degrees 59 minutes 04 seconds East, 1760.85 feet to the beginning of a curve concave to the southwest;

Thence 10), continuing to the right through said curve with an arc length of 916.87 feet, radius of 4046.76', and central angle of 12 degrees 58 minutes 53 seconds to the beginning of a compound curve;

Thence 11), continuing to the right through said curve with an arc length of 1219.45 feet, radius of 2060.76', and central angle of 33 degrees 54 minutes 17 seconds;

Thence 12) South 15 degrees 38 minutes 24 seconds East, 629.98 feet to the beginning of a curve concave to the West;

Thence 13), continuing through said curve with an arc length of 718.19 feet, radius of 5201.98 feet, and central angle of 7 degrees 54 minutes 37 seconds to the northerly line of the strip of land described as Parcel Two in Deed to the County of Santa Barbara from Eliza Pauline Curletti, Recorded August 27, 1942, in Book 552, Page 272 of Official Records of said County;

Thence 14) leaving said Railroad line and following along the Northerly line of said Parcel Two, North 52 degrees 28 minutes 00 seconds East, 311.56 feet;

Thence 15) North 45 degrees 11 minutes 15 seconds East, 207.42 feet to the beginning of a curve concave to the South;

Thence 16), continuing through said curve having an arc length of 766.64 feet, a radius of 1050.00 feet, and a central angle of 41 degrees 50 minutes 00 seconds;

Thence 17) South 85 degrees 17 minutes 30 seconds East, 207.42 feet;

Thence 18) South 83 degrees 20 minutes 00 seconds East, 704.10 feet to a point in the Easterly line of said Subdivision No. 13 above referred to;

Thence 19) North 00 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East, 3440.02 feet, more or less, to the Point of Beginning.
