This letter is in response to the possible sale of the single family house at 220 S. First street in Orcutt. My name is Randy Sinor property owner and 60 yr. resident of 255 S. First St. I strongly object to putting homeless people in a residential neighborhood. I worked over 10 yrs. in a liquor store and almost every homeless person entering the store had alcohol and/or drug problems. There is a church across the street and a nursery school 1 block away besides the two schools up the street. Where are these people going to park? There is already a serious parking problem since you (the board) sold us down the ~~river~~ street by allowing buildings to cover the entire lot with no parking required. The property has space for 2 vehicles.

I have received calls and visits from neighbors whom I seldom see; all against the sale including the Pastor at the church across the street. Why would Good Sam want to have a business so far from all of their offices etc? This project will severely decrease our property values and should be closer the homeless problem i.e. Santa Maria.
