WHEREAS, Mitch Guenthart voluntarily performed these public safety duties in addition to and beyond his current full-time employment responsibilities with the County of Santa Barbara as the General Services Vehicle Operations Manager; and

WHEREAS, Mitch Guenthart's knowledge, skills and experience contributed greatly to the overall achievement of the Sheriff's Office mission and that of Santa Barbara County government, in providing a safe and secure environment for our community members to live, work and recreate.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors commends Mitch Guenthart for his faithful and distinguished service to the citizens of Santa Barbara County, congratulates him upon his retirement in the capacity of Sheriff's Reserve Deputy, and wishes him and his wife, Rene, continued good health and many years of happiness.
