- Convened after the San Bernardino County shooting
- Composed of representatives from:
 - County Executive Office
 - Human Resources
 - District Attorney
 - General Services
 - Sheriff's Office
- Discussed and reviewed possible safety improvements
- Developed short and long term recommendations

Short Term Recommendations

- Identification Badges require ID badges be displayed inside County facilities
- Training complete Critical Incident Management (active shooter) Training
- Local Alert (keyboard button/panic button) pilot test of Lynx ePanic Button system in CEO office
- Hotline utilize the current Safety Hotline
- Updates communication of future actions to CEO and employees
- Intranet utilize internal website for safety information, tips and reminders

Long Term Recommendations

- County Facility Risk Assessments General Services will evaluate vulnerability and prioritize projects and facilities
 - FY 2016-18 Adopted Budget includes \$700,000 as initial funding to begin addressing countywide security vulnerabilities
 - Enhance security of staff processes and changes to work environments such as but not limited to:
 - Protective front entries
 - Additional audio and visual equipment
 - Ensuring adequate safety lighting around County facilities
 - Multiyear project and further reporting will be provided after analysis and completion of projects

- a) Receive and file an update on proceedings and recommendations of the Security Committee; and
- b) Determine that the above action is not a project subject to CEQA review
