Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A) Approve, ratify and authorize the Chair to execute an Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor with **Krassons, Inc.** (not a local vendor), for the provision of Electronic Health Record software support, maintenance and programming services, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$227,800 for the period July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017.
- B) Determine that the above actions are government fiscal activities or funding mechanisms which do not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment, and are therefore not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to section 15378(b)(4) of the CEQA guidelines.

Summary Text:

The Department of Behavioral Wellness has contracts for Management Information System (MIS) services, including the development and customization of the Behavioral Wellness Electronic Health Record (EHR). Approval of the recommended action will allow Behavioral Wellness to continue to use EHR software to track client data.

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Background: Krassons, Inc (Krassons) has provided EHR software for Behavioral Wellness since 2002. This agreement continues to provide for Support and Maintenance of Behavioral Wellness Mental Health EHR module and ancillary software products. This agreement also includes a contingency maximum to cover customizations and Santa Barbara County's portion of anticipated updates that are part of the Federal Affordable Care Act EHR requirements. A license fee for a version of Clinician's Gateway that will enable Behavioral Wellness to participate in the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) EHR Incentive Programs is also included in this agreement. These programs provide incentive payments to quicken the adoption, implementation or upgrade of certified EHR technology. Approval of the recommended action will allow Behavioral Wellness to reimburse Krassons for continued support and maintenance of Behavioral Wellness' EHR and anticipated required updates.

Performance Measures:

During Fiscal Year 2015-2016, Krassons achieved certification of our EHR (Clinician's Gateway) with the Office of the National Coordinator for Health Information Technology (ONC HIT) and continues working to ensure County Eligible Professionals are able to demonstrate Stage II Meaningful Use with Clinician's Gateway. Krassons also successfully implemented the Alcohol and Drug Program Module within Clinician's Gateway to further integrate our systems of care. In addition, Krassons has expanded and improved the electronic records management within Clinician's Gateway, incorporating electronic signature pads and scanning of paper documents via the IMAViser imaging system.
