REACQUISITION HISTORY

- January 7, 2016, CCWA formally requests County act to reacquire 12,214 AF of Suspended Table A Water
- February 9, 2016, Board sends letter to DWR for details of reacquisition
- June 21, 2016, DWR sends letter approving reacquisition of entire 12,214 AF to Santa Barbara County conditioned on several actions

- City of Solvang
- Santa Ynez River Water Conservation District ID1
- Carpinteria Valley Water District

SWP REACQUISITION CONDITIONS

DWR Requirements include:

- Contract Amendment to the SWP Contract,
- Compliance with California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA),
- Repayment of all past costs plus interest,
- Payment for all future costs associated with SWP allocated to that water; and
- Demonstrate water can be put to beneficial use given system capacity constraints.

COST ASSOCIATED WITH REACQUISITION

- Past State suspended costs plus interest
- Past District payments plus interest
- Future costs of SWP \$150 AF (Coastal Branch costs not applicable)



NEXT STEPS

- Direct staff to return to your Board with an Implementation Agreement with CCWA.
 - Comply with DWR conditions
 - Cover all costs
 - Address liabilities
- Ultimately execute a contract amendment
