




Issue Summary

Appeal Issues # 1 – 6

Secondary Access Requirement for Fires

- Fire officials concluded secondary road is not necessary
- Fire code does not require secondary road
- Not consistent with Local, County, and State requirements
- Not designed or sufficient for emergency fire access
- Fire officials confirmed adequate access prior to permits for existing structures



Appeal Issues # 7 – 8

Secondary Access Requirement for Agriculture

Policy BIO TC-8 in the Toro Canyon Community Plan:

New or expanded cultivated agricultural uses shall be prohibited within ESH areas and avoided to the maximum extent feasible in ESH buffer areas, except on agriculturally zoned parcels (i.e., AG-I or AG-II) subject to Policy BIO-TC-9.




Appeal Issues # 9 – 11

Consistency with County Policies and Development Standards

- County policies and development standards restrict development within ESH and protect native trees
- Proposed project conflicts with these policies
- Since existing access is adequate, there is no justification to allow proposed development in conflict with ESH policies
