
- The 2013 California Fire Code will be superseded by the 2016 version and will become State law on January 1st, 2017.
- The Fire Department adopts the 2016 California Fire Code with amendments under Chapter 15 of the Santa Barbara County Code, thereby creating the Santa Barbara County Fire Code.

Modifications

- 2016 California Fire Code modifications include:
 - Relocating code language for increased efficiency and relevance
 - Updates from the International and California Code Committees
 - Consideration of current industry practices
 - Consistency with revised state and federal laws
- There are no fee increases associated with the adoption of this code.



- County Counsel provided input, along with the Office of the State Fire Marshal.
- Chapter 15 amendments were made available for review at the County Clerk's office, on our website, and were sent to over 80 stakeholders on or before October 31st, 2016.
