


Cat Canyon- 100 Years Ago

Private Franchise Agreement

Financial Contract for ERG's existing private pipelines

- Ensure County is compensated for the use of Public Right-of-Way
- No new project is being approved today by the Private Franchise Agreement
- Private Franchise Agreement only covers <u>existing facilities</u>

County Department	Permit	Responsibility
Planning & Development	Land Use Permit/ Development Plan	Oversee safe development of facilities within Public and Private Land
Public Works	Encroachment Permit	Ensure safe development within County rights-of-way and integrity of County roadways & utilities
General Services	Franchise Agreement	Coordinate assessment and collection of fees for use of County property
Petroleum Division	Inspections and Hydrotests	Regularly inspects active and idle oil field equipment throughout County

Background

Chevron

ERG purchased the property from Chevron in 2010



Acquisition included Private Franchise Agreement (idle waste water line)





Item continued, request for detailed documentation



Physically locate all existing pipelines



Create detailed as-built engineering records



Coordinate with County Departments to ensure all pipelines are permitted & safe condition




Return to the Board with new Franchise Agreement

Field Identification of Pipelines

ERGs active pipeline system

- Fully mapped and inspected in compliance with State Law & County Petroleum Code
- Pipelines are almost exclusively built aboveground adjacent to lease roads where they can be easily visually inspected by daily operators



Field Identification of Pipelines

Identification of all pipelines within the County ROW


- Potholing
- Pipeline location with electromagnetic induction
- Flushed and idled waste water line

 All work was performed under the guidance and approval of the County's Petroleum Division Personnel




